Good environmental practices

- › Recovery and traceability of the refrigeration fluids of our fruit juice equipment after use.
- › Eventual replacement of all equipment using R22 fluids.
- › Insulation of the walls of our factory.
- › Offering our clients concentrated products which use six times less packaging and transport than the ready-prepared products.
- › Increasing the awareness of our staff in order to minimise paper prints, opting for digital documents.
- › Equipping all tradesmen with a mobile office (laptop on a network) in order to minimise journeys.

- › Decreasing the CO₂ emissions of our vehicles by using the quantity of CO₂ released as a criteria of choice.
- › Encouraging employees to cycle to work, or come on public transport (reimbursing the fares of public transport).
- › Purchasing of Eco-friendly products.

Good social/societal practices

- › Offering our clients Fair Trade products (Max Havelaar label).
- › Guaranteeing that all employees have access to treatments by taking charge of the whole of a quality mutual offer.
- › Annual installation of PEE (Company saving plan).
- › Composition of a document about security, internal regulation and risk prevention.
- › Improving the comfort of employees by buying clear and ergonomic places (2005).
- › Purchase of supplies coming from disabled workers (WCC).
